**Memorandum of Understanding**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) made on this 18<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2016.

Between

**NIELIT Guwahati** (Ministry of Communications and IT, Govt. Of India), located at the Assam Financial Corporation(AFC), Vittiya Bhawan Building , 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Md. Shah Road, Paltan Bazar, Guwahati-781008 with Extension Centres at Khanapara(Guwahati), Tezpur, Silchar, Jorhat and Kokrajhar (hereinafter referred to as 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY)

And

**Dimoria College, Khetri, Assam** hereafter referred to as 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY

This Understanding witnesseth the following:

**NIELIT Guwahati** (under the Dept. of Electronics & Information Technology [DeitY], Ministry of Communications and Information Technology, Govt. Of India), is engaged in Human Resource Development (HRD) activities in the areas of Information, Electronics and Communication Technology in both formal and non-formal sectors in the state of Assam.

Whereas as a part of expansion of activities and to be able to reach out to the remote population of the state, the 1<sup>st</sup> Party proposes to conduct initially an IT Certification training program (Certificate Course in Office Automation) for **ELIGIBLE SC/ST** students of **Khetri** free of cost. Under this training program minimum 900 (Nine Hundred) nos. of students of the college / locality are proposed to be trained during the agreement period i.e. 18.06.2016 to 31.03.2017. It is targeted to conduct minimum 3 (three) sessions in FY 2016-2017 with training target of 300 (three hundred) nos. of

SC/ST students per batch in 03 (three) batches in the financial year 2016-2017 (total 900 nos. in FY 2016-2017) . The main objective of the Certificate Course on Office Automation is to make the target beneficiaries knowledgeable about IT & also to enhance their employability on completion of the course. Moreover, it is also expected that this course will generate interest in the field of IT among the students to encourage the students to pursue higher education in the field of Information Technology (IT) and allied disciplines and to take up a career in IT.

Whereas the 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY has agreed to provide all required assistance to the 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY for smooth conduction of the program within its premises as per following terms and conditions:

1. It is agreed that the 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY will conduct "Certification of Office Automation Course" in association with 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY at the 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY's premises. The Office Automation program is a standardized short term IT course offered by NIELIT. The duration of the course is 80 (eighty) hours and is covered in 02 (two) months for the students.
2. The 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY will provide 1(one) Computer Lab (preferably having 20 PCs) available within its premises to 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY to conduct the program. The 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY will also provide an existing classroom of the college as & when required for conduction of the theory classes.
3. The 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY also agrees to help to enroll at least 900 (Nine Hundred only) nos. of ELIGIBLE SC/ST students from own college from surrounding institutes of Khetri within the agreement period i.e. in FY 2016-2017. **It is to be noted that only those students having SC/ ST Certificates in their own names shall be eligible for free admission under the scheme.**
4. This arrangement will be on responsibility sharing basis between 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY & 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY as follows. The roles & responsibilities of 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY & 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY are spelt out below:
5. **Responsibility of the PARTY's**

5.1 **1<sup>st</sup> PARTY's responsibilities (NIELIT Guwahati):**

- 5.1.1 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY will provide detailed course syllabus and course plan to the candidates through institutes one week before the commencement of batch.
- 5.1.2 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY will register the candidates admitted by 2<sup>nd</sup> Party.
- 5.1.3 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY will assure the quality of the training courses conducted by 2<sup>nd</sup> Party by conducting periodical inspection(s) and audits.
- 5.1.4 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY will nominate and appoint a Program Coordinator who shall interact with the program coordinator of 2<sup>nd</sup> Party with regards to training program in Office Automation.
- 5.1.5 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY will have to provide necessary coordination for conduction of examination and issue of certificates.
- 5.1.6 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY will pay Rs. 875/- (Rupees Eight Hundred and Seventy Five) per Candidate per batch to the 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY.

Payment will be released on completion of examination for the actual number of candidates appearing at the examination only. 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY will raise a bill after completion of the examination along with the certified copies of examination forms and attendance of the participants in the examination conducted by NIELIT Guwahati, duly verified by the Officer In-Charge of the Institute. Payment will be made against the number of candidates who appeared in the examination conducted by NIELIT. It is clarified that bills will be paid for completed batches only. "Completed" means Completion of training as well as the examination or the evaluation test. The entire expenditure on electricity, power backup, water, telephone, Internet and other common office expenses including municipal taxes and other taxes, if any, shall be paid by the 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY.

5.1.7 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY shall conduct the examination at the end of each batch. The successful students will be awarded certificates by the 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY.

5.1.8 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY shall carry on the above activities with frequent supervision from its nearest controlling Centre or from head office till validity of this MOU.

5.2 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY responsibilities Dimoria College, Khetri, Assam :

5.2.1 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY will provide at least two numbers of qualified (qualified in Information Technology/ Computer Science) faculties for each course (initially only for Certificate Course in Office Automation) and lab cum classroom preferably having 20 computers and 30 chairs with proper UPS backup and other related equipment and accessories. The rooms should have proper Internet connectivity, lighting, fans and necessary power connection and proper power backup etc. 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY will also provide a theory classroom of suitable size to conduct theory classes.

5.2.2 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY will ensure high quality training through theory and practical sessions as per the requirement of course contents duly approved by NIELIT.

5.2.3 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY to impart 80 hours of training for each batch.

5.2.4 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY shall appoint a responsible teaching faculty as **Coordinator**, for first hand co-ordination with 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY and its Faculty members within the purview of this MOU. The 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY shall provide a honorarium of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) per month to the

coordinator till validity of the agreement, at the end of a month against a bill to be submitted by the co-ordinator.

- 5.2.5 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY will send Batch Wise admission records, attendance reports and Examination Forms to NIELIT in the prescribed formats.
- 5.2.6 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY shall ensure to provide minimum of 900 nos. of minimum 10<sup>th</sup> pass ELIGIBLE SC/ST students **(It is to be noted that students having SC/ ST Certificates in their names only shall be eligible for free admission under the scheme)** of their institute/ including other students of the locality /region for each of the 03 (Three) sessions proposed during the agreement period of the financial year 2016-2017. The 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY shall enroll the students in the course with the filled up registration forms (forms to be provided by the 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY) and submit the students lists with the filled up forms to 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY for admission and registration.
- 5.2.7 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY shall provide reports to NIELIT on regular basis in the specified formats.
- 5.2.8 The 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY will allow 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY to put up its "Sign Board / Banner" related to the training program in suitable locations within the premises of 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY.
- 5.2.9 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY shall carry out the selection process of the students at its own cost and will provide the list of the numbers of ELIGIBLE SC/ST students before start of each session for the total 3 (Three) sessions in 2016-2017. The target numbers are as in point SL No. 3 above.
- 5.2.10 The selection process of the students should be transparent and the 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY may involve the 1<sup>st</sup> PARTY and other eminent academicians /personalities of the locality in the selection process.
- 5.2.11 2<sup>nd</sup> PARTY shall carry on the above activities till validity of this MOU.

**6. Information on Course Fee, Frequency of Admissions, Registrations & Examinations:**

**6.1 SC / ST Scheme:**

Under the scheme of the Scheduled Caste Sub Plan (SCSP) and Tribal Sub Plan (TSP) of the Govt. of India, SC /ST candidates are given free admission to this training program. The candidates should have valid SC / ST certificate in his / her name duly verified / certified by the District Administration.

6.2 **Frequency of Admissions:**

3 (three) sessions in financial year 2016-2017 at an average of 300 nos. of eligible SC/ST trainees in each session.

6.3 **Frequency of Examination for Certification:**

At the end of each batch, to be organized by NIELIT Guwahati.

7. **Arbitration**

Any dispute arising out of or in connection with the contract, or in respect of any defined legal relationship associated therewith or derived there from would be initially settled by the Director, NIELIT Guwahati failing which, the parties agree to submit that dispute to arbitration under the ICADR Arbitration Rules, 1996. The Authority to appoint the arbitrator(s) shall be the International Centre for Alternative Dispute Resolution. The International Centre for Alternative Dispute Resolution will provide administrative services in accordance with the ICADR Arbitration Rules, 1996 and the expenses on Arbitration shall be equally borne by both the parties.

8. **Jurisdiction**

The courts at Guwahati will have the jurisdiction.

9. **Validity, Renewal & Termination of MOU:**

- 9.1 This MOU is valid till 31<sup>st</sup> March'2017 OR till completion of training of minimum 900nos. of ELIGIBLE SC/ST students, whichever is earlier from the date of signing of this MoU.
- 9.2 This MOU can be renewed further under similar terms subject to mutual agreement.

10. **Notice**

Any notice, request, demand, approval, consent or other communication provided or permitted hereunder shall be in writing and given by personal delivery or sent by registered mail or by ordinary mail, postage prepaid, by telegram or fax addressed to the party for which, it is at its address as follows:







Both the Geology Department of Pragjyotish College and Dimoria College agree that any information which is exchanged pursuant to this MoU will be kept strictly confidential and used solely for the purpose covered by this MoU, unless such information was obtained by a third party who does not have an obligation of confidentiality toward the information-disclosing party and entered public domain.

Subject to clauses below, both the Institutions may amend this MoU by mutual consent in writing. Any amendment agreed by the Institutions shall come into effect from the date determined by the signing Institutions on potential areas.

This MoU shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall initially be valid for a period of three years. Thereafter, the Institutions, namely Pragjyotish College and Dimoria College, shall agree on mutual consent on the continued validity of this MoU. However, Geology Department of Dimoria College has freedom to continue or discontinue the MoU at its own discretion.


In any other circumstance, or other detailed collaboration between the two parties, a separate MoU shall be drawn up as and when required.


The Institutions, that is Pragjyotish College and Dimoria College, agree that this Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the basis of goodwill and shall not be legally bound. Nothing mentioned in this MoU shall deem constitute partnership between the signing Institutions apposing one party as an agent of the other. This MoU will be effective upon signature by both the Chief Executive Officers for a period of three years, at which time it will be reviewed for possible renewal for further period of three years. Either party may, on three (3) months notice in writing, terminate the MoU in advance of its normal expiration or request the recognition of its conditions.



**Preamble**

*Dimoria College* inaugurated on 29<sup>th</sup> August, 1979 is the brainchild of a group of highly motivated social entrepreneurs who in the seventies dreamt of bringing the gospel of higher education to this relatively backward tribal belt area of Dimoria, Khetri, Kamrup(M), Assam. Arts Stream of the College was brought under deficit grants-in-aid system on 1<sup>st</sup> February, 1986. This development encouraged the College to open Science Stream in HS level in the year 1987. B.Sc programme was started in 1992 and the stream got a fillip with the inauguration of the Ambedkar Science Block by the then Hon'ble Vice President of India, Sri K.R. Narayanan. Always striving for the goals of greater excellence, the College opened Post Graduate Classes in Assamese, Political Science and Economics in 1992. A new feather was added to the P.G wing in 2004 with the introduction of a totally unique and emerging Science Course in Eco-Restoration and the introduction of UGC sponsored P.G. Programme in Environment Management in the year 2008. The B.Sc Programme in Biotechnology was started in the year 2009. At present the College has five Post graduate departments. Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Adarsha Mahavidyalaya (PDUAM), Tulungia is a Model College established under the co-venture of the Central Government and the Government of Assam. The college is an outcome of the centrally sponsored scheme named "Rashtriya Uchchattar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA)" launched in 2013 by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India which aims at providing strategic funding in higher educational institutions throughout the country. Funding is provided by the Central Ministry through the State Governments and Union Territories, which in coordination with the Central Project Appraisal Board, to monitor the academic, administrative and financial advancements taken under the scheme.

The college was inaugurated on 30<sup>th</sup> August 2017 by Honourable Chief Minister, then Education Minister Dr. Himanta Biswa Sharma, Govt. of Assam. The academic session commenced on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2017 and since then it has been functioning as a Model Degree College to inculcate higher education among the rural masses of Bongaigaon district of Assam. Presently the college has a teaching strength of thirty Eight teachers serving in different departments, viz., Accountancy, Commerce, Management, English, Environmental Science, Economics, Statistics, Assamese, and Information Technology, Botany, Zoology, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics. Besides, the college has a Central library and a Computer laboratory. In addition to the teaching staff, there is ten non-teaching staff in different cadre. PDUAM, Tulungia is a residential college offering hostel accommodation for girl students only.

Arts Stream of the college was brought under deficit grants-in-aid system on 1., February, 1986. This development encouraged the college to open Science Stream in H.S. level in the year 1987. B.Sc. Course was started in 1992 and the Stream got a fillip with the inauguration of the Ambedkar Science Block by the then Hon'ble Vice-President of India, Sri K. R. Narayanan. The Science Stream was brought under deficit grants-in-aid system in 1996. The College offers PG courses in Assamese, Economics, Eco-restoration and Environmental Management as of now.

The subject of Environmental Management is proposed is bring innovation and excellence in teaching and research activities in the college. In addition, attempt will also be provide to solve the local/regional/global problems faced by the human resources. Moreover, the endeavor of both the institution will obviously be helpful in execution of environmental plan of the state government of Assam as well as in reduction environmental problems of N.E. 4. This is a non-binding MoU and there shall be no financial obligation on both the colleges.

The MoU will come into force on the date of signing and the term of validity for a period of three years at the initial stage. The execution of MoU shall be detained on mutual consent of both the college if required.


If situation compels, then separate MoUs shall be signed by both the institutions.


