World environment day was observed on 5th June 2022. Mr. Abhishek Sarkar from Aaranyak has been invited as the resource person.



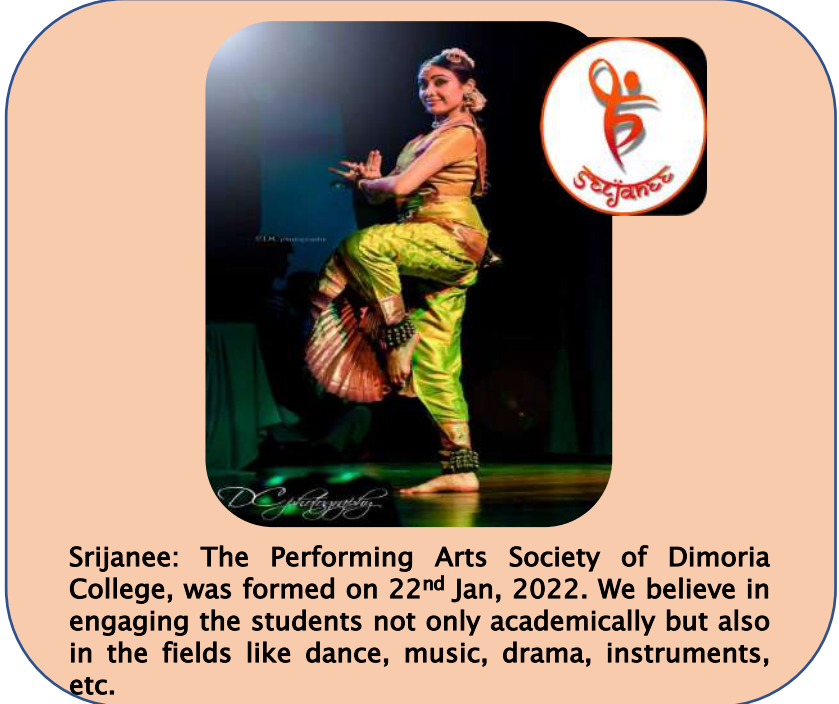

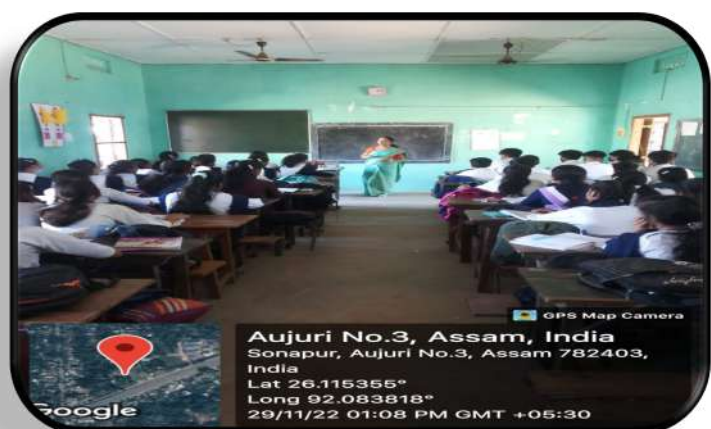
